OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Reference delegation of powers covered by item no. '1B' (Technical sanction for detailed estimate with financial concurrence as per scheme), item no. '2' (Acceptance of lowest tender), item no. '3' (Acceptance of single tenderer based on recommendation of duly constituted tender committee) and item no. '4' (Award of work by negotiations with lowest tender) in respect of Technical matters/Studies/Consultancy/Development works. The following clarifications are hereby issued for compliance:-


- (i) The Field Director may invite competitive bids, negotiate with L-1 bidder and accept the L-1 bid provided it is not a case of single/sole technically qualified bid and tender excess, if any, is within 10% of the estimate and the resultant L-1 bid is below Rs. 50 lakh.
- (ii) In case the tender excess is beyond 10% and / or L-1 bid exceeds Rs. 50 lakh, the project/scheme should be re-tendered by the Field Director with the same cost estimate i.e. without revising the cost estimate.
- (iii) In case, Field Director level TEC is of the view that revised cost estimate is warranted before re-tendering, the RCE proposal along with detailed item wise justification should be referred to Head office for a decision thereof.

(iv) In case of single tender scenario, the financial bid should be opened only after TEC is convinced that the bidder is technically qualified in all respects i.e. the bidder fulfills the entire technical criteria stipulated vide the tender document without any deviation whatsoever. After opening the financial bid, the TEC should negotiate and make efforts to bring down the bid price/ cost. After negotiation, Director may also accept the single tender/bid provided the resultant bid is within the estimate.

(v) Reference to single tender in "Delegation of Powers" means single technically qualified bid.
